1. Article format

Microsoft Word or Publisher are preferred. Typing an announcement or article into the body of an email is also acceptable. **Please send any accompanying images as separate email attachments** at the highest resolution possible. Acceptable image formats are JPG, TIF, or PNG.

2. Flyers

If you wish to submit a flyer, **please send a PDF instead of an image file.** If the flyer was created in Microsoft Word or Publisher, please submit it in that format, as well.

- a) Please note that because our bulletin has limited space available, we don't always have room to run full-page or even half-page flyers. For this reason, **we request that flyers be accompanied by a short written announcement or article containing the main information the flyer is intended to convey.** That gives us flexibility and increases the chance that your information will make it into the bulletin.
- b) **Sending more than one size of your flyer** will also increase the chances that we will have space to run it. Because shrinking a full-page flyer will not always result in it being readable, sending a full-page, half-page, and quarter-page version of your flyer is best.

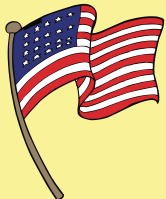

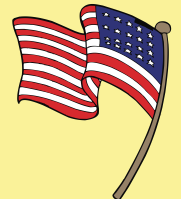
